Chapter 4 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Warwick is hereby amended to 14 add the following: 15 16 Sec. 4-50. – Unrestricted and aggressive dogs prohibited. 17 18 The owner of any dog shall keep such dog under restraint at all times and shall not permit 19 such dog to be at large within the City. 20 21 Whenever it shall be affirmed in writing by any two persons having separate residence or 22 regularly employed in the neighborhood or if the Animal Control Office or a Police 23 Officer determine that any dog is being aggressive without provocation by its actions such 24 as biting or attacking a human or any animal or in an aggressive or terrorizing manner 25 approaches a person or animal in an apparent display of attack, the Animal Control 26 Officer or the police shall have the authority to issue violations and/or impound said dog 27 and/or service notice upon the owner or custodian that such vicious action must be 28 abated. 29 30 It is unlawful for any owner of an aggressive dog to place that dog or allow it to be placed (c) 31 32 in the custody of any other person not physically capable of maintaining effective control of restricting the dog. 33 34 The penalty for violating the provisions of this section shall be a fine not exceeding \$250. 35 This fine may only be levied after an investigation into the incident is conducted by 36 Animal Control or Police and the owner or keeper of said dog is deemed to be negligent 37 in their actions. If a vicious hearing is to be pursued for the incident then the dog owner 38 cannot be fined under this section. 39 40 An owner shall not be deemed negligent if an injury or damage is sustained by an animal 41 which has trespassed onto the property where the dog resides or a person who, at the time 42 that injury or damage was sustained, was committing a trespass or other tort upon 43 premises occupied by the owner or keeper of the dog, or was teasing, tormenting, 44
