**A RESOLUTION RELATIVE TO NAMING THE PRIMARY ROADWAY BETWEEN  
TOLL GATE ROAD AND CENTERVILLE ROAD THAT PROVIDES ACCESS TO  
WINMAN MIDDLE SCHOOL AND TOLL GATE HIGH SCHOOL  
AS ROBERT SHAPIRO DRIVE**

**Resolved that,**

WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick are matters of paramount importance to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sec. 70-135 of the Code of Ordinances, street name changes may only be done by vote of the City Council after review by the Department of Public Works pursuant to Sec. 70-137 of the Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the primary roadway that runs between Toll Gate Road and Centerville Road that provides access to Winman Middle School and Toll Gate High School is unnamed; and

WHEREAS, for more than 50 years, Robert Shapiro was a dedicated public servant of Warwick Public Schools, including 12 years as Superintendent of the School Department, and 19 years as Principal of Toll Gate High School; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to honor Robert Shapiro by naming the primary roadway between Toll Gate Road and Centerville Road that provides access to Winman Middle School and Toll Gate High School as Robert Shapiro Drive; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the official name of the primary roadway between Toll Gate Road and Centerville Road that provides access to Winman Middle School and Toll Gate High School is hereby named Robert Shapiro Drive, and the Department of Public Works is hereby requested to post street signs on that street.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Director of Public Works, the City Engineer, the Chief of Police, the chief of the Fire Department, and the Director of the Emergency Management Agency (EMA).

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
